Technical Bulletin TB08-003 Change Request: 9311

Title: IWS 3.0 client launches URLs in a command window, instead of a browser, when running Windows 2003 or Vista.

Description:

URL (Uniform Resource Locator) fails to launch correctly from InfoWorkSpace/LaunchPad 3.0. A command window appears with the URL in the title instead of internet browser such as Internet Explorer or Netscape. The most common scenario is when trying to launch Conference Center from the InfoWorkSpace application.

Action:

1. On the affected client, open the **Client.bat** and **Launch.bat** using Notepad under (for Windows 2003)
the <user_home>\Infoworkspace\IWS\ directory,
e.g. C:\Documents and Settings\USER\Infoworkspace\IWS\
(for MicroSoft Vista)
the \users\<username>\Infoworkspace\IWS\ directory
2. In each file, find the line that starts with
set IWS_JAVA_COMMAND="%IWS_JRE_LOCATION%java -Duser.home"...
3. Add **-Dos.name="Windows 2000"** between java and -Duser.home.
i.e. set IWS_JAVA_COMMAND="%IWS_JRE_LOCATION%java **-Dos.name="Windows 2000"**
-Duser.home...".
4. Make sure to change both **Client.bat** and **Launch.bat** for the resolution to work completely.
Save changes to files and close them.
5. Restart client and test launching Conference Center from application. If the URL launches in a browser such as Internet Explorer, then the issue has been resolved.
